Pursuant to Section 103D-102(b)(4), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) and Subchapter 9, Chapter 3-120 of the Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), I am requesting an amendment to the exemption from Chapter 103D, HRS, for road repaving services for State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation (DOT) roadways that have experienced a water main break or emergency repair work and that require the use of Controlled Low Strength Material (CLSM) as part of the trench restoration work.

**Description of goods, services, or construction:**


Road repair services for DOT roadways that have experienced a water main break or emergency repair work and that require the use CLSM as part of the trench restoration.


**Amendment:**

This amendment is to request a 3-month extension to the exemption period extending the exemption to March 31, 2010. Procurement is in the process of finalizing the specifications and documents for a public solicitation to award a contract for paving restoration along State jurisdictions. Procurement anticipates that a bid solicitation will be posted and that a contract will be executed for these services within the next three (3) months. During the three (3) -month extensions, jobs will continue to be awarded as they have been whereby when jobs arise, request for quotations are sent to each of the vendors on the qualified list and is awarded to the lowest bidder.

Funding for any services during the three (3)-month extension will be paid out of cost 5510/4230.



CHAPTER 103D HAWAII REVISED STATUTES**

The Chief Financial Officer is reviewing a request to amend the exemption approved on December 8, 2006, that exempted the award of contracts from Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes for road repaving services for the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation (DOT) roadways that have experienced a water main break or emergency repair work and that require the use of Controlled Low Strength Material (CLSM) as part of the trench restoration work.
