Pursuant to Section 103D-102(b)(4), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) and Subchapter 9, Chapter 3-120 of the Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), I am requesting an amendment to the exemption from Chapter 103D, HRS, for road repaving services for State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation (DOT) roadways that have experienced a water main break or emergency repair work and that require the use of Controlled Low Strength Material (CLSM) as part of the trench restoration work.

Vendor Names & Address: The following contractors have been placed on the list of qualified vendors to provide road-paving services to the Board of Water Supply on DOT roadways that require the use of CLSM during the exemption.

Prior exemptions:

1. November 1, 2006 - October 31, 2007
2. Amendment No. 1 extended the exemption term to April 30, 2008
3. Amendment No. 2 extended the exemption to April 2009.

Description of goods, services, or construction:

Road repair services for DOT roadways that have experienced a water main break or emergency repair work and that require the use CLSM as part of the trench restoration.

Amendment:

This amendment is to request an additional 8-month extension to the exemption period extending the exemption to December 31, 2009. To date no contract has been awarded for these services and work is still being done to draft the minimum specifications and scope of work needed to compile a bid solicitation. It is anticipated that a bid solicitation will be posted and that a contract will be executed for these services commencing on January 1, 2010.

During the additional 8-month extension, jobs will continue to be awarded as they have been whereby when jobs arise, request for quotations are sent to each of the vendors on the qualified list and is awarded to the lowest bidder.

Funding for any services during the additional 8-month extension will be paid out of cost 5510/4230.




